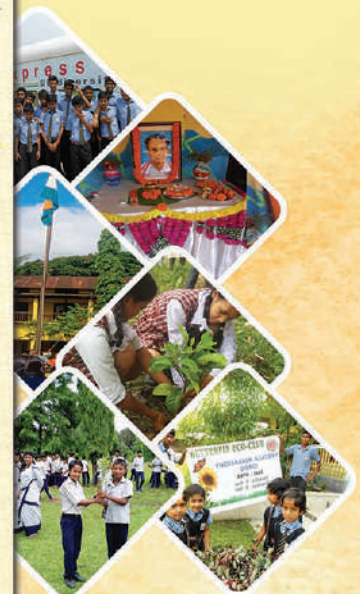

ACADEMIC CALENDAR FOR THE YEAR 2026-27



GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS :

01. Preparation for the Session for Class IX & Class X :

The new academic session 2026-27 for the High Schools and Higher Secondary Schools (excluding +2 stage), under academic jurisdiction of ASSEB (Div-I)'s starts from 1st April 2026. The schools will have to complete the following academic planning before the commencement of the academic session.

(a) School Routine: Institutions will prepare their own routine by following ASSEB (Div-I)'s model routine. Please refer to Table-2 at next page.

(b) Preparation of Subject-wise Work-schedule for the year: Teachers will prepare the work-schedule subjectwise. They will prepare their daily teaching plan before teaching in their class. The course for the year will have to be divided into 2 (two) Unit Tests, Half Yearly and Annual/ Revisionary Examination. The Head of the Institution (HOI) will supervise the preparation.

(c) Constitution of sub-committees are essential.

■ Academic Sub-committee: Will deal with academic matters such as a) preparation of school routine, b) guiding, monitoring, preparing and implementing work-schedule of teachers, guiding teachers on matters related to curriculum, syllabus and textbooks etc.

■ Examination Sub-committee: Will deal with a) planning, holding of examinations, b) declaration of results, c) Online registration of class IX students, d) Online filling up of examination forms etc.

■ CCE Sub-committee: Will deal with a) implementation, monitoring of CCE scheme, b) The formats of School Evaluation Record Cards (SERC) as given at Table-4 on page 3. The HOI is to ensure preparatory activities completed within the 1st week of April, 2026.

02. Head of the Institutions (HOIs) are required to note the following:

(a) The Academic Calendar has been planned to maximize the working hours of Schools. Schools to strictly adhere to the schedules given in this Academic Calendar.

(b) Class room teaching should be supervised on regular basis and the records of the same should be maintained as per Table-5 on page 3.

03. Academic Programme for 2026-2027 also includes :

→ Holding diagnostic tests in English and Mathematics for all class IX students to identify weak students and undertake remedial classes at the beginning of academic session

→ Imparting Remedial teaching in all subjects in all classes from time to time.

→ Holding all Examinations, evaluation and declaration of results.

→ Holding HSLC Examinations in the month of February, 2027 in schools concerned. Schools which are not Examination Centres shall remain open during the period of HSLC Examination and normal school programme should continue.

→ Organising Annual sports in school & Prize distribution ceremony.

→ Holding parents'/guardians', Teachers' meeting (PTM) after Half yearly Examination of Class IX and Revisionary Exam of Class X.

→ Making preparation for the Academic Session 2027-28.

04. Staff meeting:

a) Will organise Staff meeting on the last Saturday of every month or last working day of the month. b) Will review activities of the month and c) Preview activities for the next month on regular basis.

05. Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) :

CCE scheme should consist of two basic components :-

(i) Evaluation of pupils in scholastic areas (i.e. in the area of teaching and learning) consists of 2 (two) Unit Tests: (a) One Unit Test to be held before Half-Yearly Examination and (b) Another Unit Test after the Half-Yearly Examination. A revisionary test for Class X covering the whole course will be held in the month of January, for class IX Annual Exam will be held in the month of February/March 2027.

(ii) Evaluation of pupils in the co-scholastic areas i.e. in the areas of work experience, games and sports, literary, art and cultural activities, Scouts and Guides, moral education, Yoga and general conduct.

06. CCE Records :

All Schools to maintain records of CCE for every individual student in the school i.e. records of Unit Tests, Half-Yearly and Annual Examination.

School authorities to provide : (i) printed cards/folders for maintaining records of school-based evaluation (ii) A Model Format of SERC is given at Table-4 on page 3. SERCs to be signed by parents/guardians after Examination and the School will use the SERC as Progress Report Card.

Unit Tests should be held in the 5th and 6th period. On Saturday it should be held in the 3rd and 4th period. Please refer to Table-3 on Page 3.

Importance of Unit Tests (UT) :

The Unit Tests are necessary :

➤ For inducing regular study habits in pupils.

➤ For analysing the performance of students and teachers undertaking timely remedial teaching to remove weaknesses of pupils.

➤ To make pupils aware of their progress in studies at every step and improving themselves.

➤ Parents/Guardians can also keep track of the progress of their children/wards.

➤ To be held in a formal atmosphere in the class room within two periods of the subject concerned. Pupils to be taught to be strictly honest while sitting for Unit Test and other exams.

Note:

(i) Question paper in a particular subject (after U.T. and should include every important teaching point of the course and no selective reading should be done.

(ii) Question papers on language should test knowledge, comprehension and skills of expression and in other subjects, it should test the pupils' knowledge, understanding, capacity for application and skill

08. Remedial Teaching : Remedial Teaching constitutes an important part of the teaching-learning process. Every teacher has to :

➤ identify the weak pupils in the subject concerned on his/her performance in previous examinations.

➤ undertake intensive remedial teaching after every UTs/Examinations.

➤ Students promoted from Class IX to X need to have minimal level of achievement to cope with the Class-X

course. This may necessitate rigorous remedial teaching for slow learners.

➤ Teachers to analyse the kinds of errors (linguistic and conceptual) committed by a pupil and use proper methods of teaching so that the errors may not recur.

Every teacher need to maintain a TEACHER'S LOG BOOK and to maintain records on :

- Date
- No. of Students present
- Name of the Topic/Lesson
- Teaching Strategies adopted for the class
- What TLM (Teaching Learning Materials) is used for the topic/lesson
- Students' involvement
- Signature of the Teachers
- Head of the Institution to collect students' feedback on a particular format from every student once in every six months.

09. Procedure for promotion of students to the next higher class (in case of Class IX) :

Should be decided on the basis of marks secured in the two Unit Tests, Half-Yearly Examination and Annual Examination.

* Unit Test marks	: 20%
* Half-yearly Examination marks	: 30%
* Annual Examination marks (For Govt. Schools Annual Examination 40% + General 10%)	: 50%
* Pass marks in each subject	: 30%

10. Evaluation of Pupils in the Co-scholastic area : The co-scholastic area comprises of the following components :

➤ Work Experience (WE) : Includes activities such as gardening, bamboo work, wood work, tailoring, knitting, embroidery, paper work, clay-modelling, including tree plantation, beautification of school campus and other activities.

➤ Scouts & Guides : Each and every school is required to introduce "Scouts and Guides" as one of the co-scholastic activities. The HOI will select a teacher for the purpose who will be trained by the Scouts/Guides organisation.

➤ Games and Sports : (Two periods per week to be allotted)

➤ The school to provide the facilities for important games like football, volleyball, tennis, cricket, etc. and sports like athletics, throws, swimming, yoga and drill including Scouts and Guides.

➤ Literary, Art and Cultural Activities : Includes debating, creative writing, quiz, recitation, drawing, painting, dramatics, music, dancing, etc.

➤ Observance days: Special days have been shown in the Academic Calendar as Observance days Schools are advised to observe the cultural activities on the various occasions viz Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat, Janjatiya Gaurav Divas Etc. Schools are requested to observe these days by organising literary and cultural activities, debates, quiz competitions etc. relevant to the theme of the observance days. [Please refer to list on Observance Days] on page 3.

➤ General conduct : Includes qualities like discipline, punctuality, regularity, cleanliness, sense of responsibility, self reliance, diligence, initiative taking, leadership, courage, determination, co-operation, civic consciousness, tolerance, honesty, good manners, spirit of social service, interest, attitude, kindness, patriotism, forgiveness, truthfulness, non-violence. The conduct of the students inside and outside the school is to be observed by the teachers and to rate the General conduct of the students.

➤ Ethics in School Curriculum : Ethics literally mean a system of moral principles of behaviour. Schools play an important role in inculcating a strong sense of ethics in the minds of the young children. Besides imparting Moral Education during Morning Assembly hours, sense of value can be imprinted in the minds of the students through various co-curricular activities via. Role Play, Debate, Extempore speech, story writing, Art work etc. in the school. Observance days and important days like Annual School Day, Prize Distribution Day etc. Students' involvement in these activities will make an impact in their minds which will govern their behaviour and make them responsible citizens.

➤ Assessment of co-scholastic activities : In the three assessments in an Academic Year for co-scholastic activities, students are to be evaluated in Grades as follows :

A = Excellent B = Good C = Average
D = Fair E = Poor

11. Scheme of Evaluation of Environmental Studies :

(a) The Board has adopted "Infusion model + Project"

(for imparting Environmental Education).

The various concepts of Environmental Education have been included in various subjects to link the concepts with real life situations and ensure active involvement of students.

(b) Projects of Environmental studies-

It is a part of the IA of Social Science of 10 marks. Students have to prepare project on field study or on a problem related to the environment preferably in the month of October/November 2026.

Guidelines on Field Study :

Environmental Studies – field study.

The field work: visit to a local area to collect data and record findings. Every student has to submit a report on his/her experience gathered during such field work individually or in groups.

Method of Field Study :

- Proper selection of the study area, it may include city, village, tea garden, industrial area and so on.
- Concerned Teacher has to have clear knowledge of the area and the project to be done under his/her guidance.
- For field study, students are required to carry a small bag with pen, note book, camera, measuring tape, drinking water bottle and other necessary materials.
- Subject chosen for the field study to be specific (e.g. deforestation, landslides, forest-fire, floods, droughts, pollution etc.)
- After field study, students to prepare report either individually or in groups.
- Reports to be prepared on the basis of actual field work and about 60% work.
- Report to be written in about 250 to 300 words.
- Report to be submitted to the HOI through concerned teacher.

- Topography : Observation of the natural and artificial physical features, i.e water bodies, valleys, etc.
- Flora and Fauna : Observation of plant species and animals. Changes with change in season, deforestation, loss of habitat if any.
- Views to improve the situation : Some ways for solving the environment problems.

B. Visit to a polluted site : (industrial area/residential sewage/deposited waste materials given out by factories, garbage dump)

- Name of the location : Photographs of polluted area to be attached
- Causes and effects : Factors related to the pollution of the area. (residential sewage, raw materials used, products of an industry, toxic gases released from small industries, waste materials by factories.
- Effect on health : Whether people are exposed to chronic stomach, respiratory diseases, skin diseases like dermatitis, rashes, allergy etc.
- Identification of environmental pollution : Caused by (a) water pollution, (b) air pollution and (c) land pollution.
- Views to improve the situation : On the basis of collected data a line of action can be suggested to reduce those problems.

C. Study of simple ecosystem of a local river, stream or pond :

- Name of the location : Photographs to be attached wherever necessary.
- Topography : Present condition of the water basin to be documented, whether the water basin is connected and also the water volume, speed of flow, depth, surface temperature etc.
- Biotic components : To give a clear idea about food chain of various producers different aquatic plant species and consumers e.g. water fleas, larva of insects, fishes, frogs, fish eating birds, snakes etc.
- Identification factors affecting ecosystem : The crisis points- (a) food problem, (b) scarcity of water, (c) erosion, (d) landslide, (e) loss of habitat, (f) loss of agricultural land etc.
- Activities of local people : People taking bath, throwing waste materials, washing animals, clothes etc. in rivers and ponds, and then using the same water for drinking as well as other domestic purposes.
- Views to improve the situation : On the basis of collected data, remedies can be suggested for solving problems. (e.g. people to be informed about toxic effects of detergents and various diseases caused by polluted water). People should be made aware of keeping river, stream or pond free from pollution.

12. Physically Challenged Students :

- (A) The CWSN category students having (a) Blindness, (b) Low vision with 60%, (c) Mentally retarded with cerebral palsy with 60% will be entitled for helper studying in Class X (Class IX Passed) and 20 minutes extra time per hour, in HSLC Examination 2027.

- (B) The CWSN category students having Hearing impairment with 80% will be entitled for 20 minutes extra time per hour, in HSLC Examination.

- (C) Permission for extra time etc., shall be provided by Inspector of Schools of the district.

13. General Assembly (15 minutes duration) :

To start with a devotional song (3 minutes duration) like "Yande Maataram", "O' mor aaponaar desh", etc. or a *Guru Vandana*, or a prayer to God should be acceptable to all 12 minutes to impart value education among students and create awareness on the following :

- **Personality Development :** Cleanliness, good manners, kindness, truthfulness, righteous conduct, honesty, sincerity, punctuality, discipline, diligence, self reliance, dignity of labour, hard work, moral courage, sense of hygiene and scientific temper.

- **Social and National values :** Ideals of love, tolerance, forgiveness, loyalty, peace, non-violence, patriotism, democracy, freedom, justice, secularism, equality, service, co-operation, hospitality, duties and responsibilities as citizen.

- **Global values :** universal brotherhood, respect for all religions, international understanding and co-operation, protection of environment, truth and justice, proper understanding of religious teachings, understanding that God is one and we all are God's children. The value-education in General Assembly should be in addition to value-education imparted in classrooms and the right examples set by teachers through their own conduct. Apart from value-education, the General Assembly should be utilized for making important announcements to students by the HOI or other teachers, or reporting of important items of news of the day, etc. Both teachers and students should be involved in the process of discourses during the General Assembly.

• Important Information/Instructions :

Some important information - instructions regarding subjects, lessons etc. are given on page 3. H.O.Ls are required to bring these to the notice of the children and teachers.

• Education on Road safety :

School children should be taught road safety skills to come to schools, while walking, cycling or using buses. They should understand the traffic signals and road signs.

• Swachh Bharat Mission : Swachh Vidyalaya

Swachh Bharat Mission : A mission for cleanliness was launched at Rajpath in New Delhi by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on 2nd October, 2014. Bapuji, the father of our nation had a vision of clean India, a country where people of all caste and creed, rich and poor alike will live in a clean, hygienic environment.

• What role the schools can play :

The future of the nation is being built in schools. Swachh Bharat Swachh Vidyalaya is a campaign for fulfillment of the mission of Swachh Bharat Swachh Vidyalaya campaign is a campaign for keeping the school and its environment clean and hygienic. A clean environment, provision of safe and pure drinking water and sanitation and hygienic conditions are the distinctive characteristics of a clean school. Schools must have provision of pure drinking water, toilet facilities (separate for boys and girls), and provision of soap for hand washing.

Students should be taught :

- to keep the surroundings of the school clean.
- to wash hands before eating meal and after using toilet
- to be careful not to waste water.

• Involvements of the students

Groups of students may be formed comprising 5-6 students who would work on rotation basis. Class wise groups by rotation will check that the compound of the school is clean; that there is availability of drinking water and soap for washing hands. Another group may check that the toilets are usable all the time. A group of students may check the cleanliness of classrooms. To make the Swachh Vidyalaya campaign a successful one, senior students may be designated as **School Ambassadors** for campaigning of Swachh Vidyalaya.

• Child abuse awareness :

School should take adequate measures for creating awareness and prevention of child abuse. Child abuse awareness for prevention of the same and creating a compassionate society for the welfare of students.

• Respect for elders :

The concept of imbibing the values of good manners, good behaviour, respecting Teachers, Parents and Elderly people should be inculcated in the students.

• Witch hunting :

Schools to educate children on the Evils of Witch Craft and the Evil Practices prevalent in the society and make them aware for the eradication.

• Drug abuse :

Awareness should be built on Drug abuse and its menace to society. Effort taken for awareness and eradication of the same.

• Tobacco Control :

Sections 4 and 6 of COTPA Act, 2003, regarding use/sale of Tobacco products in and around Educational Institutions must be followed.

Schools should also play the role of imparting knowledge for awareness and undertake measures for development of Towns/ Cities / Villages and also on the following:

- Tree plantation
- Social Evils
- Cleanliness
- Hygiene & Sanitation
- Visit of students to nearest Post Office/Bank/BDO office/ Circle Office/Common Service/Markets/Shops/Industries etc.
- Adult Education
- Respect for women in society.
- One Class everyday to be devoted to Co-curricular or Remedial Teaching or Inviting guest lecturers on different topics.
- Schools to divide the children into different Activity Groups/ Houses and organise inter house competitions amongst them.

14. ASSEB (D-I) will monitor the implementation of the Academic Calendar from time to time.

Violation of any provision in this Academic Calendar by any HOI will be viewed seriously and will lead to appropriate action.
